

## Grant Funding Available

The Carl Moyer Memorial Incentive Grant Program funds the early replacement of older gross polluting diesel engines with cleaner more efficient technology available today. The North Coast Unified Air Quality Management District has allocated 1 million dollars for the 2019-2020 grant cycle to fund replacement projects for equipment in the following categories:

**On-Road:** Heavy Duty Trucks & Buses

**Off-Road:** Cranes, Dozers, Backhoes, Tractors

**Marine:** Commercial Fishing Vessel engine repowers
