

# INCENTIVE GRANTS 2018- 2019

## FOR EQUIPMENT POWERED BY DIESEL ENGINES

The Carl Moyer Memorial Incentive Grant Program funds the replacement of older gross polluting diesel engines and machinery with new cleaner-than-required engines and equipment. The North Coast Unified Air Quality Management District has allocated up to one million dollars for the 2018-2019 grant cycle to fund replacement projects for equipment in the following categories:

**On-Road:** Heavy Duty Trucks & Buses

**Off-Road:** Cranes, Dozers, Backhoes, Tractors

**Marine:** Commercial Fishing Vessel Engine Repowers
