

# Air Resources Board AQMIS Database

To find information on Air Quality in Humboldt, Del Norte, and Trinity Counties, please access the AQMIS database found on the Air Resources Board website.

The NCUAQMD sends all air monitoring data collected in Humboldt, Trinity, and Del Norte counties to the ARB for inclusion in this database. This provides access to the public and allows for individuals to create air monitoring reports tailored to their individual needs. Please note, this database is update only periodically, so expect the latest data to be at least 3 months old.

To access this database, follow these steps:

- 1) Go to the website <https://ww2.arb.ca.gov>
- 2) Under the heading, What We Do, choose the box “Measuring Air Quality”.
- 3) Then choose the box, “Ambient Air Quality Monitoring”.
- 4) Finally, choose the box, “AQMIS”.

Now you have arrived in the AMQIS Database. Here you have many options for data searches and analysis. The choice which will allow you to access official air quality data from a specific area is the “Air Quality Data” box.

Choose the “Air Quality Data” box to open the query tool.

Make a selection for steps one through 5 based on your interests. If you have an incomplete selection, no data will be retrieved!

Availability of data:

Humboldt County: PM10, PM2.5, ozone, carbon monoxide, sulfur dioxide, nitrogen dioxide

Trinity County: PM2.5

Del Norte County: PM2.5
