FY 2021-2022 Fire Prevention (FP) Grants Quick Reference Guide:

CAL FIRE's Fire Prevention Grants Program provides funding for fire prevention projects and activities in and near fire threatened communities that focus on increasing the protection of people, structures, and communities. Funded activities include hazardous fuels reduction, wildfire prevention planning, and wildfire prevention education with an emphasis on improving public health and safety while reducing greenhouse gas emissions.

▪ **Eligible Applicants Include:**

- State Agencies
- Federal Agencies
- Native American Tribes
- Joint Powers Authority (JPA) if the entities involved are eligible applicants
- Local agencies, including:
 - Cities
 - Counties
 - Fire protection districts
 - Community services districts
 - Water districts
 - Resource conservation districts
 - Special districts
- Certified local conservation corps
- Fire Safe Councils with a 501(c)(3) designation
- Other qualified non-profit organizations with a 501(c)(3) designation

▪ **Fire Prevention Project request amounts:**

- Capital Equipment cannot exceed \$ 250,000
- Indirect Costs may not exceed 12%
- No Minimum or Maximum project award amounts
- Matching Funds are not required
